Summary of Progress this Report

For the last two weeks we have continued development on Tyr, our automated project configuration tool and library. Right now, we are mostly in a maintenance stage with this library and are mostly doing small tweeks. This week however, we added testing and database tooling support and added some helpful user validations. We also added support for private GitHub/TravisCl projects.

We are also working on Yggdrasil, our web application which will house projects and where a user will be able to manage their projects. We finished up a big piece of work surrounding authentication and we have moved on to creating more functional UI components surrounding projects, such as pages for viewing the project and creating the project.

Plans for Upcoming Reporting Period

As a team, we plan on continuing maintenance on Tyr and release v0.3.0, which will include the private projects, database tooling, and testing tooling choices. We will look at adding support for Google Cloud on Tyr. On Yggdrasil, we plan to continue working on the projects UI and connect it to the backend. We will also work on the invites system for collaborators. Finally, we will spend a small amount of time getting Skadi, a node module which will be used to send heartbeats and data flow information from a web app to some database. This will be used as our "monitoring framework".
